
It's the Law



DO

What is a secured load?

A load is secured when no cargo or debris can slide, shift, fall or become airborne.



DON'T

What is an unsecured load?

A load is unsecure when it has not been covered, fastened in or attached to the vehicle.

How to Cover and Secure

A Cover your load with a tarp and fasten



B Use a tarp big enough to cover the trailer/truck bed



C Tie down and secure items

D Re-check your load

Written notice or citation



Turned away
