Agenda Item 3 – OC Waste & Recycling's FY 22/23 Financial Report by Trang Doan - Section Manager, Financial Services

This report presents the financial status of OC Waste & Recycling for the second quarter of FY 22/23 (October - December). Included in the report is financial information related to tonnage, expenditures, revenues, and cash balances.

System Tonnage

Total OC Waste & Recycling system tonnage received during the second quarter of FY 22/23 was1,258,824 tons, consisting of 860,482 in-county tonnage and 398,342 importation tonnage. Bylandfill site, second quarter tonnage was as follows:Olinda Alpha LandfillIn-county tonnage353,128 (41%) of total in-county tonnageImportation tonnage173,156 (43%) of total importation tonnage

Frank R. Bowerman Landfill In-county tonnage 379,344 (44%) Importation tonnage 154,543 (39%)

Prima Deshecha Landfill In-county tonnage 128,010 (15%) Importation tonnage 70,643 (18%)

Revenues

As of second quarter of FY 22/23, revenue recorded in OC Waste & Recycling's Enterprise/Operating (Fund 299) was \$67,981,044 or 39.8% of the revenue budget of \$170,595,155.

Revenue recorded in OC Waste & Recycling's Capital Project Fund (Fund 273) was \$538,662 or 0.7% of the revenue budget of \$79,847,098. This is from the recorded interest revenue.

Revenue recorded in OC Waste & Recycling's Importation Net Revenue Sharing Fund (Fund 295) was \$13,009,298 or 25.6% of the revenue budget of \$50,800,000.

Sources of revenue received as of second quarter of FY 22/23 included:

- \$71,143,180 All Tonnage Revenue (87.3% of total revenue received)
- \$3,674,175 AB 939 Surcharge Revenue (4.5%)
- \$2,918,747 Other Revenue (3.6%)
- \$2,531,004 Interest Revenue (3.1%)
- \$1,261,899 Leases & Royalties (1.5%)

Expenditures

As of second quarter of FY 22/23, expenditures and encumbrances recorded in OC Waste & Recycling's Enterprise/Operating (Fund 299) totaled \$75,696,805 or 26.5% of the modified expense budget of \$285,396,026.

As of second quarter of FY 22/23 expenditures and encumbrances recorded in OC Waste & Recycling's Capital Project Fund (Fund 273) totaled \$834,193 or 0.5% of a modified expense budget of \$154,866,849. Expense was mostly for the soft cost of capital projects such as design or professional services.

As of second quarter of FY 22/23 expenditures and encumbrances recorded in OC Waste & Recycling's Importation Fund (Fund 295) totaled \$1,048,184 or 2.1% of the modified expense budget of \$50,946,839. This is primarily for quarterly disposal fee to the State and host fee to the cities.

As of second quarter of FY 22/23, OC Waste & Recycling's major categories of expenditures were:

- \$43,264,248 Services & Supplies (54.7% of Total year-to-date)
- \$16,634,746 Salaries & Employee Benefits (21%)
- \$13,024,866 Equipment (16.5%)
- \$3,679,546 Taxes, Fees, Assessments (4.7%)
- \$1,531,707 Post-Closure Maintenance (1.9%)
- \$813,658 Capital Projects (1%)
- \$162,117 AB 939 Surcharge Program (0.2%)

Cash Balance and Reserves

As of December 31, 2022, the OC Waste & Recycling's Enterprise/Operating Fund 299 had a cash balance of \$318,008,860.

As of December 31, 2022, the OC Waste & Recycling's Enterprise/Operating Fund 299 had an available reserved balance of \$50,831,274.
