#### AGENDA ITEM 4 – Budget & Financial Report/Update

This report presents the financial status of OC Waste & Recycling for the second quarter of FY 23/24 (October - December). Included in the report is financial information related to tonnage, expenditures, revenues, and cash balances.

#### **System Tonnage**

Total OC Waste & Recycling system tonnage received during the second quarter of FY 23/24 was 1,255,374 tons, consisting of 891,161 in-county tonnage and 364,213 importation tonnage. By landfill site, second quarter tonnage was as follows:

#### Olinda Alpha Landfill

In-county tonnage 365,162 (41%) of total in-county tonnage Importation tonnage 156,724 (43%) of total importation tonnage

#### Frank R. Bowerman Landfill

In-county tonnage 388,397 (44%) Importation tonnage 159,494 (44%)

#### Prima Deshecha Landfill

In-county tonnage 137,602 (15%) Importation tonnage 47,995 (13%)

#### Revenues

As of second quarter of FY 23/24, revenue recorded in OC Waste & Recycling's Enterprise/Operating (Fund 299) was \$76,308,173 or 39.7% of the revenue budget of \$192,123,694.

Revenue recorded in OC Waste & Recycling's Capital Project Fund (Fund 273) was \$942,426 or 1.1% of the revenue budget of \$86,500,000.

Revenue recorded in OC Waste & Recycling's Importation Net Revenue Sharing Fund (Fund 295) was \$21,3853,596 or 42.1% of the revenue budget of \$51,938,001.

Sources of revenue received in the second quarter of FY 23/24 included:

- \$86,339,064 Tonnage Revenue (87.1% of total revenue received)
- \$7,411,816 Interest Revenue (7.5%)
- \$3,956,773 AB939 Surcharge Revenue (4%)
- \$804,027 Leases & Royalties (0.8%)
- \$592,515 Other Revenue (0.6%)

#### **Expenditures**

As of second quarter of FY 23/24 expenditures and encumbrances recorded in OC Waste & Recycling's Enterprise/Operating (Fund 299) totaled \$87,614,162 or an approximate 27.6% of the modified expense budget of \$317,047,788.

As of second quarter of FY 23/24 expenditures and encumbrances recorded in OC Waste & Recycling's Capital Project Fund (Fund 273) totaled \$78,446,148 or 58.5% of the modified expense budget of \$134,184,182.

As of second quarter of FY 23/24 expenditures and encumbrances recorded in OC Waste & Recycling's Importation Fund (Fund 295) totaled \$1,152,721 or 2.2% of the modified expense budget of \$51,938,001. This is primarily for the first quarter disposal fee to the State and host fee to the cities.

As of second quarter of FY 23/24, OC Waste & Recycling's major categories of expenditures were:

- \$78,446,148 Capital Projects (46.3%)
- \$47,889,136 Services & Supplies (28.4%)
- \$18,017,158 Salaries & Employee Benefits (10.6%)
- \$17,585,306 Equipment (10.4%)
- \$4,960,094 Taxes, Fees, Assessments (2.9%)
- \$2,061,140 Post-Closure Maintenance (1.2%)
- \$315,188 AB 939 Surcharge Program (0.2%)

#### **Cash Balance and Reserves**

As of December 31, 2023, the OC Waste & Recycling's Enterprise/Operating Fund 299 had a total cash balance of \$ 374,035,933 including earmarked and operating reserve cash.

As of December 31, 2023, the OC Waste & Recycling's Enterprise/Operating Fund 299 had an available reserves balance of \$101,648,194.
